

1. Membership

Joining Fee of \$30 payable on joining then each year a membership fee paid as follows:

Alternative 1	\$200 per annum paid as a whole (3 free months), normally \$600
Alternative 2	\$25 per month (normally \$45)

2. Membership Entitlements

Your \$30 membership fee includes

1. A fishing bag valued at \$42 – containing a measuring ruler, scales, note book, folder, newsletter, drink holder and pen.
2. BCF Discounts
3. Attended BCF Information sessions
4. Attend all Club functions
5. Use of EcoPark fishing rods and tackle.
6. Fishing tuition
7. Achievement certificates
8. Entry for awards and prizes.

3. Member's Responsibilities

As the club is operated by members

- The Club seeks co-operation of all members in encouraging safe behavior
- The Club invites members to make a reasonable effort to maintain safety
- While the Club encourages safety, it does not take responsibility for unsafe conduct by members.

Each member will be expected to abide by the Club rules as outlined on the application to join form.

4. Age Requirements

- A member must be at least 6 years old.
- A member who turns 14 before July 1st in any year may continue membership until June 30th.
- All members under the age of 12 must be supervised by a parent/guardian.

Leader

- Provide tuition to the members of the Club
- To report to the EcoPark board on the Club's requirements and progress
- To notify the Club members by email of Club activities.
- Tally score cards and record on main board
- To set up and pack up on Club meeting days
- Act as a referee when requested by Club members

Captain

- Elected by Club members
- To assist the Club leader
- To hand out and collect score sheets
- Represent club members at Committee meetings

Social Representative

- Elected by Club members
- Participate in planning and preparation of social events
- Can be a parent of a Club member

8. Awards

A monthly prize will be awarded to the member who catches:

- The most fish
- The longest fish
- The heaviest fish
- The mystery fish determined by the Club leader

Tallies will accumulate for the perpetual trophy awarded at the Christmas event.
